

## Castle Climbing Centre Green Lanes, Stoke Newington, London, N4 2HA

The climbing centre is not open to the public in the morning. If the door is locked you will need to ring the bell and wait for someone to come and let you in. This may take a few minutes if the duty staff are in a part of the centre far from the entrance. The doorbell can be heard throughout the centre so do keep ringing if no one comes at first.

### Lunch

As there is only 30 minutes for lunch it is easiest to bring a packed lunch with you. There is a cafe onsite which opens from midday and provides refreshments as well as lunch options, but it can be very busy. Tea and coffee is provided throughout the day and you are welcome to bring your own refreshments too.



### Travel by tube

- Manor House (Piccadilly Line) is the nearest tube station. Take exit 3 and walk down Green Lanes (away from the park) for about 5 minutes until you see the Castle on your left.
- Finsbury Park tube (Victoria/Piccadilly/National Rail) is also nearby, about a 15 minute walk.

### Travel by bus

- The 341 and the 141 stop just outside The Castle on Green Lanes (Myddleton Avenue Northbound / Lordship Park Southbound). The 106 is the next closest stop (Green Lanes).
- The 253, 254, 259, 279, 29 and 393 also stop nearby.
